

WALK-A-WYAL NATURE TRAIL

The Wyalkatchem Walk-A-Wyal Nature walk trail was kindly funded by Lottery West in 2007. The trail was put together by the local Natural Resource Management Officer at the time, Hannah Sadler, along with the Wyalkatchem Shire and the Wyalkatchem LCDC.

Halfway through the walk trail, there is a resting shed which was kindly donated by the Wyalkatchem Rotary Club.

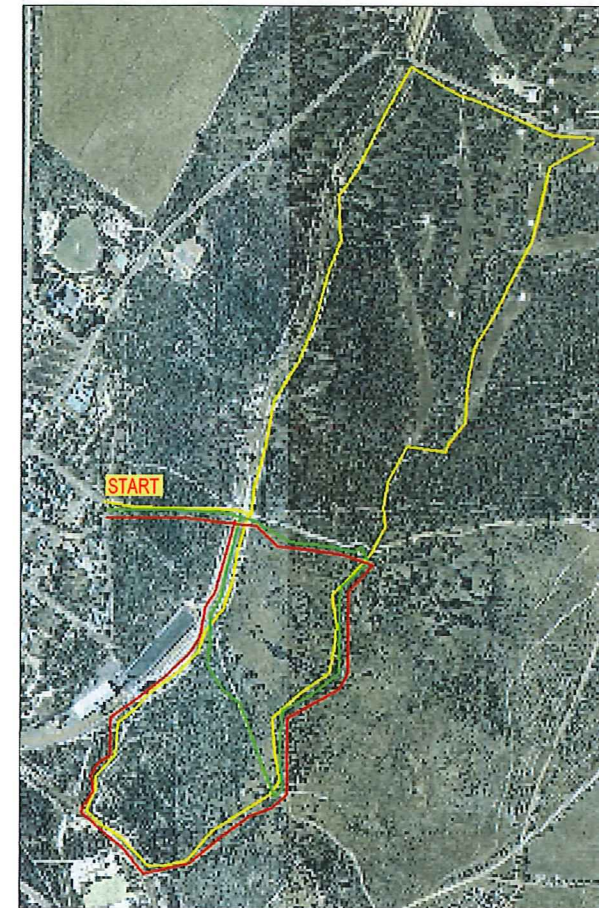


TRAIL VIEWS

The Green route is 2.4kms in distance and it takes you through some native regeneration, along the creek line and near the CBH receivables site.

The red route is 3kms long and takes in some beautiful native vegetation, the CBH receival site and the school dam.

The yellow route is 5kms long and is the complete Walk-A-Wyal Nature trail. It takes in a number of different vegetation communities, the Wyalkatchem well and the entire CBH infrastructure site.



HOW TO GET THERE

Turn up Honour Avenue, past the Historic Wyalkatchem Hotel, then a right turn at **Piesse St.**

The Walk Trail starts where the road bends. Cars can be parked on the side of the road.
